This document reviews how to connect PAX devices using Android OS to the Internet. You will need to determine your device, if the Internet connection is via Wi-Fi or Ethernet, and then complete the steps in the applicable section:

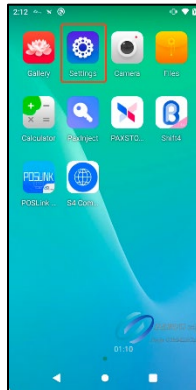

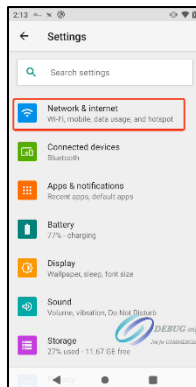
## ***A800 – Connecting via Wi-Fi***

To connect via Wi-Fi, complete the following steps:

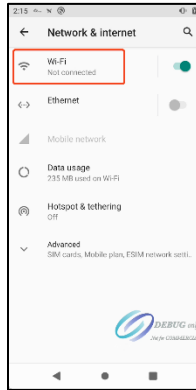
1. Tap **Settings**.



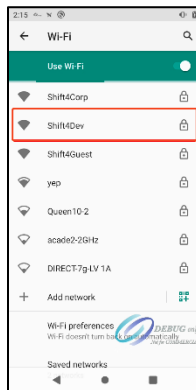
2. Tap **Network & internet**.



3. Tap **Wi-Fi**.



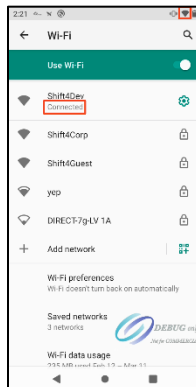
4. The device will scan for Wi-Fi networks. Tap the network to which you would like to connect.



5. Enter the Password to the Wi-Fi network you selected, and then tap **CONNECT**.



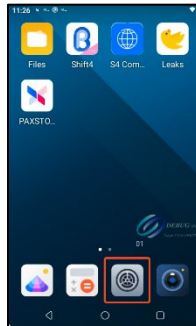
6. If the connection was successful, “Connected” will be displayed under the selected Wi-Fi network and the Wi-Fi icon will appear in the status bar at the top.



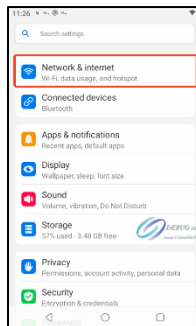
## ***A35 – Connecting via Wi-Fi***

To connect via Wi-Fi, complete the following steps:

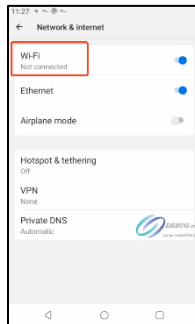
1. Tap the **Settings** icon.



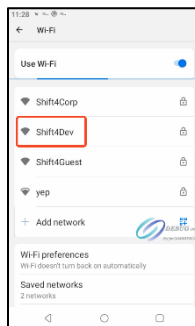
2. Tap **Network & internet**.



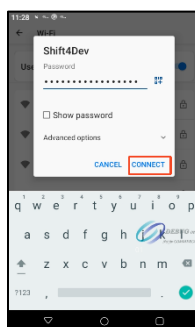
3. Tap **Wi-Fi**.



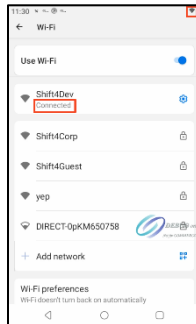
4. The device will scan for Wi-Fi networks. Tap the network to which you would like to connect.



5. Enter the Password to the Wi-Fi network you selected, and then tap **CONNECT**.



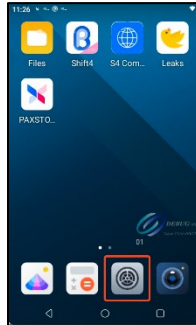
6. If the connection was successful, “Connected” will be displayed under the selected Wi-Fi network and the Wi-Fi icon will appear in the status bar at the top.



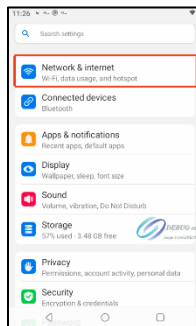
## ***A35 – Connecting via Ethernet***

To connect via Ethernet, complete the following steps:

1. Ensure the Ethernet cable is plugged in to the red Ethernet jack on the device's cable.
2. Tap the **Settings** icon.

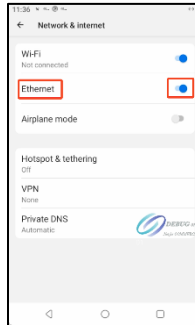


3. Tap **Network & internet**.

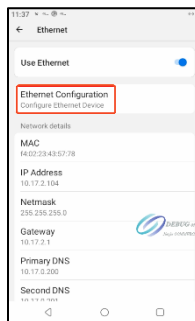




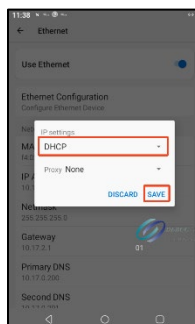
4. Ensure Ethernet is on (indicated by ). Tap **Ethernet**.



5. Tap **Ethernet Configuration**.

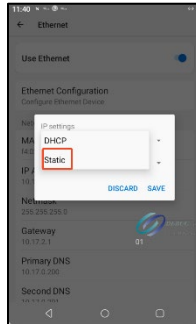


6. (If applicable) In the IP settings drop-down list, select **DHCP** if in use. Then, tap **SAVE**.

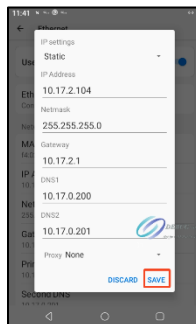


7. *(If applicable)* If a static IP address is in use, complete the following steps:

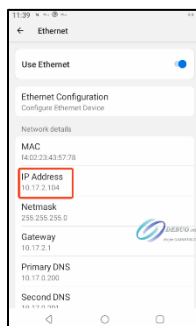
- In the IP settings drop-down list, select **Static**.



- Enter the IP address information. Then, tap **SAVE**.



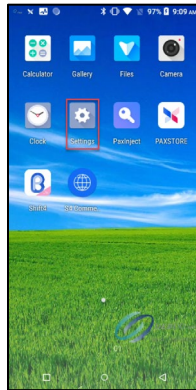
8. Under IP Address, the settings entered will be displayed.



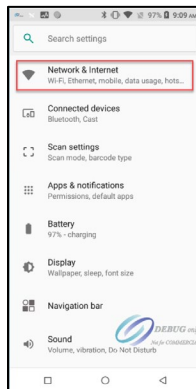
## ***A77 – Connecting via Wi-Fi***

To connect via Wi-Fi, complete the following steps:

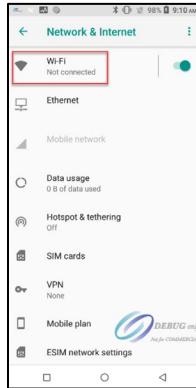
1. Tap **Settings**.



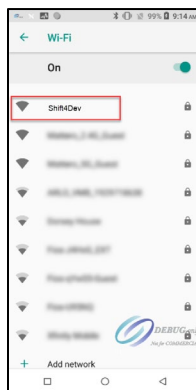
2. Tap **Network & Internet**.



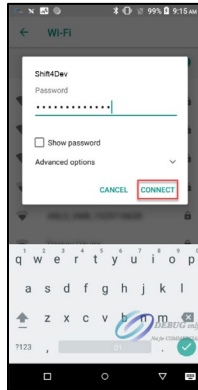
3. Tap **Wi-Fi**.



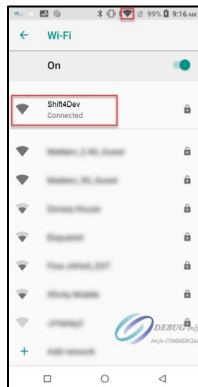
4. The device will scan for Wi-Fi networks. Tap the network to which you would like to connect.



5. Enter the Password to the Wi-Fi network you selected, and then tap **CONNECT**.



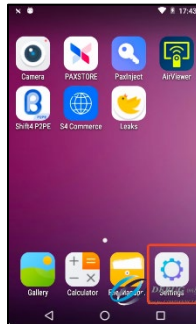
6. If the connection was successful, “Connected” will be displayed under the selected Wi-Fi network and the Wi-Fi icon will appear in the status bar at the top.



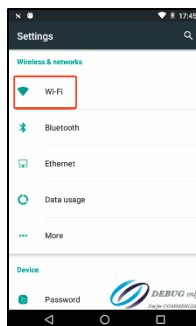
## ***A80 – Connecting via Wi-Fi***

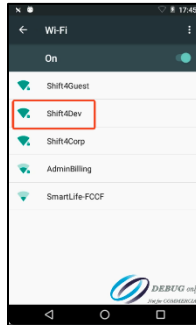

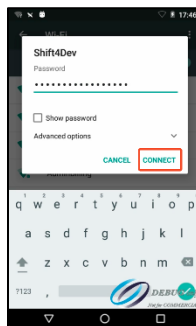

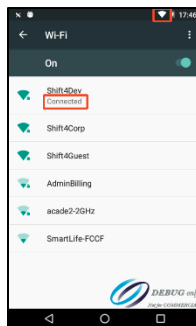
3. The device will scan for Wi-Fi networks. Tap the network to which you would like to connect.

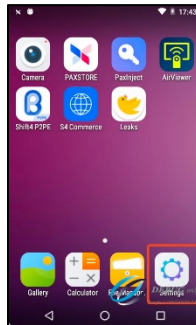
5. If the connection was successful, "Connected" will be displayed under the selected Wi-Fi network and the Wi-Fi icon will appear in the status bar at the top.



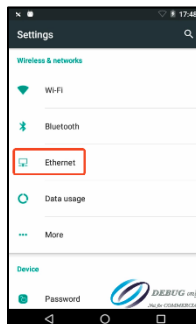
## ***A80 – Connecting via Ethernet***

1. Ensure the Ethernet cable is plugged in to the Ethernet jack on the device.
2. Tap **Settings**.

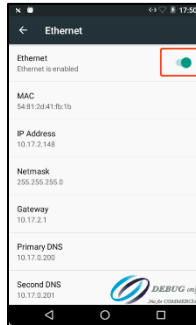


3. Tap **Ethernet**.

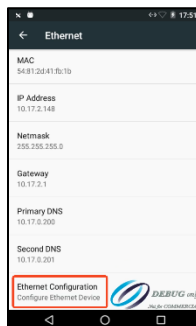




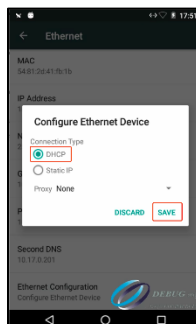
4. Ensure Ethernet is on (indicated by )



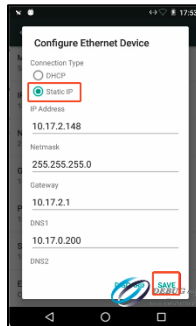
5. Scroll down to the bottom, and then tap **Ethernet Configuration**.



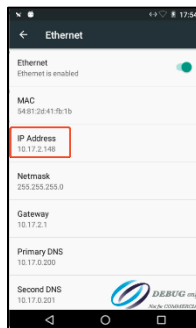
6. (If applicable) Under Connection Type, tap **DHCP** if in use. Then, tap **SAVE**.



7. (If applicable) Under Connection Type, tap **Static IP** if in use, enter the IP address information, and then tap **SAVE**.



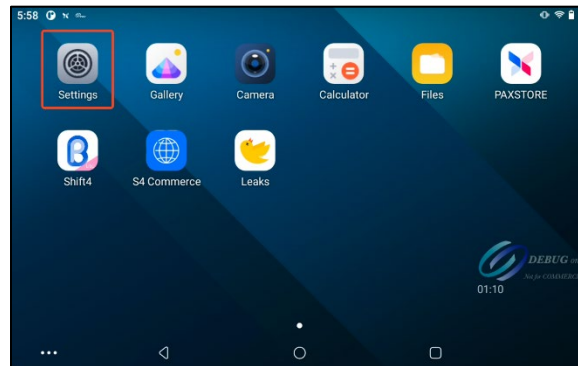
8. Under IP Address, the settings entered will be displayed.



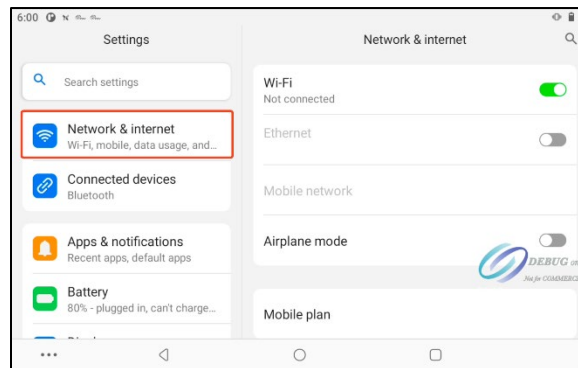
## ***A3700 – Connecting via Wi-Fi***

To connect via Wi-Fi, complete the following steps:

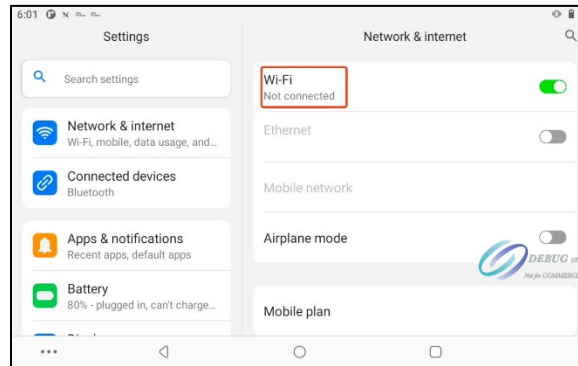
1. Tap **Settings**.



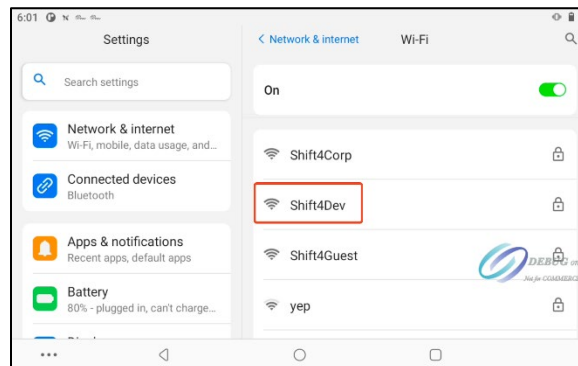
2. Tap **Network & internet**.



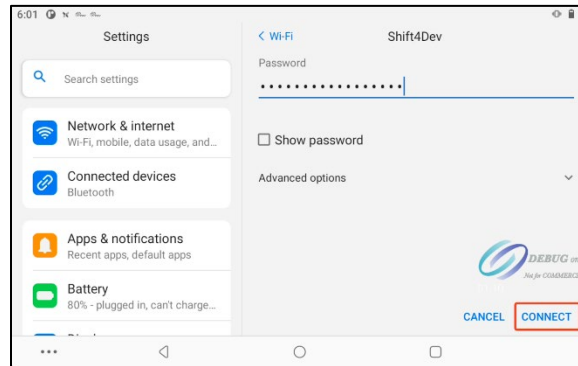
3. Tap **Wi-Fi**.
